## IIT DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY IN ARCHITECTURE

More than ever, the world needs more informed, more innovative, and more critically involved architects. Population growth, changing climate, and continued depletion of natural resources call into question received planning and design methods. Architects have emerged among design professionals to lead the understanding, organization, reclamation, and reimagining of our cities to meet the challenges of our future.

Founded in the late 1990s as a laboratory for applied research and scholarship, Illinois Institute of Technology's Ph.D. Program in Architecture attracts graduate students from the Americas, Asia, Europe, and Africa; these students converge onto our National Register of Historic Places Mies-designed campus to research a broad range of topics within a multi-disciplinary environment. Students enrolled in the Ph.D. program explore the historic and contemporary intersections among architecture, culture, and technology through two areas of specialized research: History, Theory, and Criticism (HTC), and Technologies of the Built Environment (TBE).
